We have in service at Sunbury Wastewater Treatment Plant the following Helical Rotor Pumps:

- 7 Allweiler-Seeburg 750.1
- 2 Allweiler-Seeburg 100.1
- 3 Mono Merlin E range.

These pumps had given us many years of reliable service but were becoming very expensive to maintain, the decision to scrap these excellent pumps was not far off being made when we decided to try in one of the 750.1 pumps your reconditioned rotor and your supplied stator both fitted for around half the usual price, this pump was moving highly abrasive heavy primary sludge which would usually wear out the rotor in about 6 months, to our surprise and delight your rotor was still in service after 12 months of hard work.

Since that exercise all the Helical Rotor Pumps have been fitted out with your Hard Chromed Rotors and your supplied Stators It is not uncommon for us to get 2 years out of a rotor and in some instances where the sludge is not as aggressive as primary sludge we are getting much longer service.

We have not only increased service life of the pump it has now become very economical to keep these pumps operational saving us huge amounts in capital expense to replace them, it has also become viable to keep a stock of spare rotors and stators on site to enable rapid replacement if needed with very little downtime as compared to the six week wait for the original rotor and stator to be ordered in.

We are extremely happy with the standards set by Alpha Pumps in quality and service and have no hesitation in recommending your company to anyone that might need this service.
